Who we are

The Mwezi Foundation donates solar light libraries to schools in Kenya to enable children to do their homework at night. Each light library costs £180 for 15 lights. We also donate home lighting systems to orphanages, which cost about £140 per room.

The role

To write to relevant Trusts to ask for funds for the Mwezi Foundation to expand.

What it involves

- Write letters to the existing list of Trusts which we have identified as potential donors.
- Follow up and maintain links with Trusts, providing feedback on funds used.

Why you might consider this role

- This is a voluntary role, largely because we are a very small charity which is still growing.
- You would be able to work the hours that suit you, probably only a few hours a week, possibly nothing during the school holidays.
- It's a really rewarding charity to be involved with. The pupils receiving the lights benefit directly and see their lives transformed as they can put the hours in to complete extra studies for their exams. And the children in the orphanages benefit hugely from having rooms which are lit at night, which also enables them to do their homework.
- The Mwezi Foundation is looking to grow over the years so you could be in near the beginning. You would also be able to help with decision making as we donate more light libraries and home lighting systems in the future.
- This role is very flexible and provides some continuity on a CV if you are in between jobs, perhaps with family responsibilities. For those starting out on a career, this would provide valuable work experience.
